### **Ryan Cambridge Memorial Scholarship Policy**

Scholarships funded by the Sunset Hills Children’s Foundation will be offered to graduating seniors residing in and attending a comprehensive or continuation high school in the Victor Valley. (To include: Victor Valley Union High School District, Apple Valley Unified School District, Hesperia Unified School District, Snowline Unified School District, Lucerne Valley Unified School District).

Recommended standard amounts per annum (award amounts to be determined by scholarship committee):  
Ryan Cambridge Memorial Scholarship..... up to \$ 500.00 - 1,500.00 (per year for 2 years at Community colleges, Vocational/Technical Schools).

1. This scholarship will be presented to one student who is pursuing a career in the construction, architectural, engineer or building related industries – including technical/trade schools. The selected candidate must have shown outstanding qualities of character, involvement in school and community activities. The scholarship committee will also consider student(s) who have worked to further his/her studies at the college level and show promise of usefulness to business and society later in life.

Scholarship committee will require the following from all applicants.

- Application form
- Personal letter written by the applicant explaining what course of study he/she wants to pursue and why he/she chose this particular field of study. (Minimum one page letter required).
- A current certified high school transcript (can be obtained through counselor).
- A letter of recommendation or endorsement from school teacher, administrator, program coordinator or upstanding member in the community.

Committee's screening process may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Review of financial need
- Average grades in high school courses that are compatible with the college major selected, which may help demonstrate the student's future success in continuing education.
- Consideration of applications to attend out of state institutions.

Additional information:

- After scholarship award, the student may request in writing that the money be held until enrollment, should they need to postpone their education for one or two years.
- After the postponement, the student must notify the Foundation of intent to enroll, submitting their name address, etc, and school of enrollment.
- No funding is available after four years from the date of high school graduation (this includes any and all postponements).
- No funding is available for post-graduate work.
- The recipient of an award must carry a minimum of 12 semester units – or equivalent thereof.
- Renewals depend upon the Foundation's assessment of progress based upon submitted transcripts and the maintenance of a 2.5 accumulative GPA.
- Scholarship renewals are limited to three years (for a total of 4 years).
- Scholarships will not be awarded to students who are employees of the Sunset Hills Memorial Park Family of Mortuaries or are related to employees of the Sunset Hills Memorial Park Family of Mortuaries.
